The services your Community Health Coordinator provides or helps you access will depend upon your situation and needs, but here is one example of how ICW can help.

A mother of young children was admitted to the hospital, requiring a lengthy stay and rehabilitation. Her spouse worked several jobs, their rental home was being sold, and they did not have family nearby. ICW worked with providers and community support systems to help the family:

- Access medical equipment and supplies
- Set up home health services
- Arrange caregiver services, so that her spouse would not miss work
- Receive emotional support and coaching
- Locate a new rental property and assist with the move
- Complete SSI and other forms
- Schedule virtual care visits to limit travel
- Connect the family to resources for transportation, food, clothing, and other needs
